Review of systems. **PLEASE CIRCLE ALL THAT APPLY**

General/Constitutional

Weight loss or gain, strength, ability to conduct usual activities, exercise tolerance

Skin/Breast

Rash, itching, pigmentation, moisture or dryness, texture, changes in hair growth or loss, nail changes

Breast lumps, tenderness, swelling, nipple discharge

Eyes/Ears/Nose/Mouth/Throat

Headaches, vertigo, lightheadedness, head injury, migraines

Double vision, tearing, blind spots, pain

Nose bleeding, colds, obstruction, discharge

Dental difficulties, bleeding gums, dentures

Neck stiffness, pain, tenderness, masses in thyroid or other areas

Cardiovascular

Chest pain, palpitations, fainting, shortness of breath on exertion or laying down, bluish color of the skin, hypertension, heart murmurs, varicose veins, blood clots, pain in calf or thigh muscle.

Respiratory

Chest pain, shortness of breath, wheezing, cough, respiratory infections, tuberculosis (or exposure to tuberculosis), fever or night sweats

Gastrointestinal

Appetite (poor or excessive), problems swallowing, indigestion, abdominal pain, heartburn, nausea, vomiting, jaundice, constipation, or diarrhea, abnormal stools, flatulence, hemorrhoids, recent changes in bowel habits

Genitourinary

Urgency, frequency, unusual (or change in) color of urine, stones, infections, kidney problems, hesitancy, dribbling, acute retention or incontinence, lose of sexual desire, potency, genital stores, discharge, venereal disease

(Female) Age of first period _____, last period, severe cramping, hormone imbalance, post-menopausal bleeding, painful intercourse, number of pregnancies _____.

Musculoskeletal

Pain, swelling, redness or heat of muscles or joints, limitation, of motion, muscular weakness, loss of muscle strength, muscle cramps

Neurologic/Psychiatric

Convulsions, paralyzes, tremor, incoordination, change in skin sensation, difficulties with memory or speech, sensory or motor disturbances, or muscular coordination.

Predominant mood "nervousness", emotional problems, anxiety, depression, previous psychiatric care, unusual perceptions, hallucinations

Allergic/Immunologic/Lymphatic/Endocrine

Reactions to drugs, food, insects, skin rash's, trouble breathing

Anemia, bleeding tendency, previous transfusions, Rh incompatibility

Lymph node enlargement or tenderness. –extreme thirst, excessive urination, weakness, hormone therapy, growth, secondary sexual development, intolerance to heat or cold.
